Indy Choir's New Board Members Reflect Diversity, Strategy

INDIANAPOLIS – February 8, 2011 – The Indianapolis Symphonic Choir's recent addition of three (3) new members to its Board of Directors reflects diversity of the community, as well as significant steps forward with Board development as outlined in its current Strategic Plan.

Kyle Henne, serves as the Director of Development and Philanthropic Information for the Community Health Network foundation. Alicia Curtis is with Ivy Tech Community College, and Nora Barnard is founder of Nora Barnard International.

Indianapolis Symphonic Choir Board President Peter Fellegly states, "The addition of these fine new members to our Board further expands our diversity and depth in terms of professional background and skillset, creed, race and age. Diversity isn't limited to a just a few criteria. Just like planning a good dinner party, our Board increasingly reflects persons who bring different items to that table, creating an effective, high-performing gathering." The Choir's current strategic plan includes notable efforts toward board development in the years leading up to its 75th anniversary season in 2011/2012.

The Indianapolis Symphonic Choir is a 501(c)3 non-profit performing arts organization based in Indianapolis, and 2010-2011 marks its 74th season. The organization presented a 10-day concert tour through China in June 2010. A frequent artistic partner with the Indianapolis Symphony Orchestra, the Symphonic Choir is governed by a volunteer Board of Directors, administered by a professional staff, and is made up of more than 160 singers, auditioned annually, who perform 25 concerts each season reaching in excess of 25,000 persons.
